

RESEARCH REPORT REQUIREMENTS:

(Point values for each are listed in parenthesis)

Title Page:	lists the name of the project, your name, grade, and date (5)
Table of Contents:	lists what is in the report and what page everything is on (5)
Abstract:	brief overview of the project – includes the title, summary of purpose, question, hypothesis, procedure, and results (10)
Introduction:	states your purpose along with any information that led you to choose your topic (10)
Final Research Report:	outline, introduction, body of paper, conclusion (100)
List of materials:	list of items and equipment used in your experiment (5)
Procedure:	step-by-step description of your experiment's procedure including variables and how you collected, measured, and recorded data (20)
Data:	minimum of two charts and graphs with written summaries for each (10)
Analysis:	tells how you interpreted your result based on your experiment and your research (10)
Conclusion:	tells what worked, what didn't work, what you would change (10)
Bibliography:	includes all sources and written materials (10)
Glossary:	includes words and definitions that are needed to understand your report and experiment (5)

Everything must be typed and organized neatly in a folder or binder.

You will also be graded on your display board, final draft of report, and presentation in science as well as your composition packets in CA.
