

<u>Curriculum:</u>

- The math standards adopted by our school district will guide instruction. These can be found at <u>http://www.corestandards.org/Math/</u>
- We will be using the Glencoe math curriculum for Pre Algebra that includes two soft cover books. There are 2 volumes, and only 1 book will be used at a time. We will be using the Pearson math curriculum for Algebra which is a hardcover textbook. There will also be various supplemental resources used to coincide with FSD adopted curriculum.

Work Expectations:

- Your overall grade will be determined by two categories: Weekly Records (worth 40%) and Assessments (worth 60%)
 - <u>Weekly Records</u> will consist of in-class and at-home assignments. These assignments are given to practice skills. These will be graded based on **effort** (amount and quality of work shown) and **accuracy** (correct answers).
 - <u>Assessments</u> are given to prove mastery of math concepts. These can be in the form of projects, quizzes, and tests.
 - Retake/redo opportunities are available for most math work to earn back points. This form is available in class AND on Google Classroom. This often requires intervention, so please make arrangements with me to get help.
- Grading system used: A (90-100%), B (80-89%), C (70-79%), D (60-69%), F (0-59%).

Cheating:

Any time someone else does your work or you write someone else's answer on your page that is considered cheating. The person "sharing" work and answers is at fault as well. Please do not cheat; instead, get help from me as soon as you can. The consequence of cheating is earning a ZERO and a phone call to your parent/guardian.

Make-up Work:

If you know you are going to be missing a school day, GET YOUR WORK before you leave if it is available. Make-up work will be available on the "HELP! I missed class" board as well as Google Classroom. It is <u>YOUR RESPONSIBILITY</u> to copy any notes that were missed and seek help from me during Advisory, or before/after school. You will have 3 DAYS to turn in all make-up work. Make arrangements with me if you need more time.

Google Classroom:

Classroom will be used keep a track of weekly records and in class handouts/notes. Classroom will also provide supplemental resources and communication; HOWEVER, it will rarely be used for submitting work.

Extra Help:

Do not wait to seek help. Ask questions in class or come see me during these other times:

- 1. Before school on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays: 7:45-8:10
- 2. After school most days until 3:15
- 3. Advisory on Tuesdays during Teacher Access

High school credit earned prior to high school and transcribed with a non-numerical grade will apply to fulfilling high school graduation requirements.
