game. If they stay for after school activities, the closed campus policy is still in effect. They will have school discipline if they go to the Freeman Store.





Winter Weather Information

According to several forecasts, this winter may bring more snow than we've seen in recent years. We want to be sure all Freeman families are prepared in advance for possible schedule changes due to inclement weather.

Communication

If the weather impacts the school day, we will share updates by 6:00 a.m. through:

- Automated emails, texts, and voice messages-please ensure your contact information in Skyward is accurate and Freeman SD is not blocked.
- The Freeman School District website and our Facebook & Instagram pages.
- Local news stations (note: their reports may not always be accurate please rely on Freeman messaging first).

Weather Monitoring

When snow or ice is in the forecast, our Transportation Director and staff drive routes early in the morning to check conditions. Maintenance crews begin plowing and clearing parking lots and sidewalks before staff and students arrive. Even with these efforts, icy spots may remain—please use extra caution!

The elementary and middle school students go out to recess unless the temperature is below 12 degrees (wind chill is factored into this decision). We rely on the Apple Weather App to make this determination. Please ensure your students are dressed for the weather.

Delays and Cancellations

Our goal is always to keep schools open when possible.

- Two-Hour Delay: School begins at 10:15 a.m. Breakfast will not be served. Staff should report when they can do so safely.
- Cancellation: All school programs, activities, events and facility usage are canceled for the entire day and evening, even if conditions later improve. The day will be made up on the next scheduled make-up day.

Safety Tip: Walk Like a Penguin!

- Wear shoes with slip-resistant soles.
- Take short steps and keep your arms slightly out for balance.
- Hold onto your vehicle when getting in or out.
