

OSPI HIGH SCHOOL DIRECTORY - OPTION TO OPT OUT

The Washington Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) High School Directory is new this year (RCW 28A.150.515 and RCW 28B.10.041) and will include key information about students and their parent or guardian, which is shared with the Washington student achievement council and institutions of higher education. All students, parents and guardians can opt out of having their information included. Unless you opt out, the directory will include names, addresses, email addresses and telephone numbers of students and their parents or legal guardians and the associated statewide student identifier. If you do not wish for your student's information, or your own, to be included in this directory, you have the right to opt out. To opt out, please complete and submit Freeman High School OSPI Directory Opt-Out by Thursday, October 24th.
