What is Camp Kesem?

Camp Kesem is a FUN, FREE, and SUPPORTIVE week-long summer camp to support children (6-18 years old) who have lost a parent to cancer, have a parent undergoing cancer treatment, or whose parent is a cancer survivor in the local Spokane area & beyond.



INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLY

1. Navigate to kesem.force.com/login
2. Select "Sign Up" located in the bottom right-hand corner of the page.
3. Fill out the designated fields with YOUR information (not your camper's information), and ensure you have selected "Camper Family" when prompted to "Select Registration Type."
4. Once you have entered your information, you will be redirected back to the home page. Scroll to select "Add Family Member."
5. Add all of your camper(s) here, as well as any other parents or guardians you would like included within your "Camper Family."
6. Once complete, navigate to the "Pick a Camp" tab. Select "Whitworth University" from the location drop-down list.
7. Select which camp session you would like to sign up for. Select "Register" if there are currently open spots, or "Waitlist" if there are not. If there are not open spots, we highly recommend that you register for the waitlist. We can often accommodate these children.
8. Select which camper you will be signing up for Camp Kesem, and begin the application. Repeat this process for each camper that you are registering.
9. Once you've completed the application(s), you can view the status on the "My Applications" tab. You will also receive a confirmation email that your registration(s) have been received.




