Spring is in full swing, and with it comes an exciting opportunity for our students to showcase their skills in the upcoming Spring 2025 Smarter Balanced Assessments (SBA)! We wanted to provide you with the schedule for testing at FHS, so you can mark your calendars.

- 10th Grade ELA: May 5th & 6th, 8:15 am
- 10th Grade Math: May 20th & 21st, 8:15 am
- 11th Grade Science (WCAS): May 8th, 8:15 am

We encourage you to ensure that your student's computer is fully charged prior to testing, so they can dive into the assessments without any technical hiccups. Additionally, if your student will be absent on any of these testing dates, please reach out to Heidi Youseph at your earliest convenience. We'll work together to schedule a make-up time that fits your student's needs. Thank you for your ongoing support in your student's academic journey!

ASVAB TESTING IS NEXT WEEK

The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) is a standardized test used by the U.S. military to assess applicants' aptitude and determine their eligibility and suitability for different military jobs. It also serves as a career exploration tool for high school and college students, helping them identify their strengths and interests in various fields, including those outside of the military. We will be holding the test here at Freeman for our 11th and 12th grade students who are interested next Tuesday, April 22nd, at 8:15am in the Library. 
