

O: How can I donate items/services to the auction?

We would like to know about all donation items by next Friday, September 30th, so we have time to organize everything before the event. We are looking for anything that will draw a bid (gift certificates, tickets to events, experience packages, homemade items, Freeman stuff, etc.)

O: Can students attend the event?

This event will be an adults only event because of the venue and nature of the event. But all proceeds are going to benefit the student-athletes of Freeman so come out and support!

Q: What if I want to stay out at the resort?

The resort has given us a block of rooms at both their spa side as well as the hotel next to the venue. Simply call 1-800-523-2464 and give them code 9935. Be sure to specify which room type you would like. As of now there are only 12 rooms left.

Q: What is the goal and plan for the proceeds?

The primary goal would be to raise enough money to cover our sports travel fund and officials fees. We have had hugely successful programs and last year we spent over \$24,000 on hotel rooms for post season play! Our officials bill was over \$15,000 and they have raised their rates 8% this year. All monies above those expenses will be shared amongst all athletic programs as needed. The ASB funds are managed by the ASB Student Council, ASB Advisor, the Principal, Athletic Director and ASB Bookkeeper.

In order to receive the highest quality image, we are requesting that you submit your photos on-line this year (see directions below). Many studios will be abl this for you. The senior portrait must be 2"x3" (portrait) and at least 300 dpi. Scanned baby pictures should also be 300 dpi and approximately 2"x3". Deadline to submit both these photos to the yearbook is Friday, October 14.

- <u>Directions to upload your photos:</u>

 A. Before uploading your photo, please save the image as a full size save and **RENAN** your senior portrait to your students first_lastname (ex. Jenny_Smith) and your baby portrait to first_lastname_baby (Jenny_Smith_baby) so that it is easy to identify photos.
- B. Next, go to www.hjeshare.com and enter the school code for Freeman

 C. You will be asked to put in your name, email and phone number.
 D. You will then be asked to "Agree to Terms", which is typical.
 E. You will then be asked to browse to your photo. Simply navigate to where you have
- the photo saved, select the photo, and click on upload.
 You are almost done it will then ask for some information about the picture, such as who is in it - please type in your child's name (we always use the students give name). That's all there is to it!
- (If you cannot submit your photos on-line, please deliver them to Pia Longinotti at the high school in a envelope labeled with your name. Please do so as soon as possible, prior to October 14)

Thank you for your participation in the inaugural year of Freeman High School ASB's Football Tailgating! The goal of this event is to provide the Freeman community a way to come together in support of Freeman High School's students and athletes. To ensure a safe and fun experience for all, please follow the following guidelines.

- Tailgating will be allowed only in the designated area the southwestern most parking lot next to Jackson Road, where busses pick up students at the end of the day
- To ensure easy access to spectators who require shorter walking distance to the venue,
 the six parking spots closest to the sidewalk will be left open
- The lot will open at 4:00 p.m. prior to Varsity football games for tailgating
- Propane or electric grills are allowed but must be extinguished by kickoff or upon entering the stadium and must not be left unattended
- · Open flames are NOT allowed
- Alcohol of any kind is NOT allowed. Violation of this state law may result in arrest or citation
- Generators are allowed; however, the fuel must be stored in approved safety containers
- Please keep your space clean. Garbage can be placed in the dumpsters on the south side of the MS/ES MPR
- All tailgaters must leave the lot within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the game
- Failure to adhere to any listed regulation may result in removal from the tailgate area
- Freeman School District reserves the right to remove any tailgater(s) who poses a public nuisance or hazard at any time
- All Freeman School District rules, policies, and laws will be enforced
