Welcome to a new school year! I am so excited for what this year will bring for all of us. I look forward to the time we spend together, creating amazing musical experiences together. As a member of our choir program, there are specific procedures that will be implemented this year:

- Always do your best. We all make mistakes, and singing can be intimidating for some. In my class, this is a safe place to learn together, making mistakes along the way.
- Respect others' efforts. It's fine to laugh at ourselves, but be sensitive to others when they make mistakes as well (we all do!)
- BE ON TIME. I will be taking attendance right after the tardy bell rings. You must be in your place on the risers, with your folder and pencil, or you will be marked tardy.
- No gum or food allowed. Water bottles are fine, in fact I encourage them, to stay hydrated.
- Take proper care of your music and folder. You will be fined for lost or damaged music.
- No one is allowed to leave class, at any time, without permission and a hall pass. If you do, you will lose participation points.
- We abide by the 10/10 rule. You may be excused with a pass 10 minutes after the tardy bell and 10 minutes before the end-of-class bell.
- Each student gets three hall passes each semester, per school policy
- Cell Phones: If I am working with you, there are NO cell phones.

With the above in mind, my grading policy will be the following:

Participation----50%

- Being punctual to class and ready to go when the bell rings
- Rehearsal etiquette: Being fully engaged in whatever we are doing (warm-ups, sight-singing, sectionals, etc.)
- Staying in the classroom the whole time
- Not being disruptive to other students

Quizzes/Assessments-----20%

- We are implementing sight-singing this year, in our endeavor to become musically literate. We will spend time each week learning how to read music and sight-sing, and there will be quizzes every other week. There will also be written quizzes.

Performances-----30%

- Each member of choir is equally important, and performances are mandatory.

Concert Attire:

Girls: Black pants or skirt (knee level or below), Black or white top, or solid black dress,
Black shoes

Boys: Black pants, white collared shirt, tie, and black shoes

I am so excited for this year! I have high expectations, both of myself, and every person in our choir. Every student has a voice, and it is my goal to help each one find that voice, and to gain confidence in doing so.
