

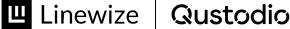

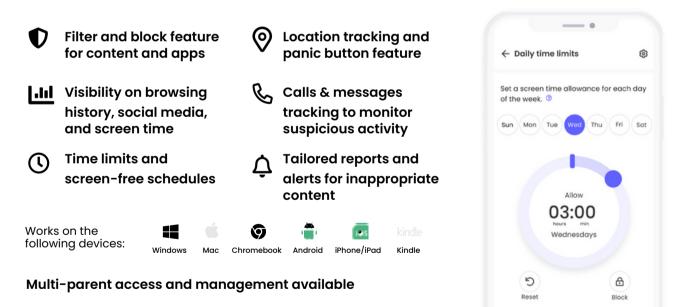
App for Parents & Families
