Red Velvet White Chocolate Chip Cookies

1 13 c. all purpose flour (scoop & level)
4 t. unsweetened cocoa powder
1/2 t. baking soda
1/4 heaping t. salt
1/2 c. unsalted butter, softened
1/2 c. granulated sugar
1/4 c. packed, light brown sugar
1 large egg
2 t. red food coloring (or 1, as needed)
1/2 t. gel-red food coloring
1 1/2 t. vanilla extract
1 t. white vinegar or lemon juice
3/4 c. + 1/3 c. white chocolate chips (semi-sweet chocolate chips may be substituted)

1. In mixing bowl, whisk together flour, cocoa powder, soda and salt. Set aside.
2. In bowl of stand mixer, fitted with paddle, cream together butter, granulated and brown sugars until combined.
3. Add egg, red food colorings,

vanilla and vinegar.

4. Add flour mixture and mix until just combined. Add in 3/4 c. chips, setting aside remaining 1/3 c. chips to use *after* baking.
5. Cover bowl. Chill 1-2 hours until dough is nearly firm.
6. Preheat oven to 350°F near the end of dough chilling.
7. Bake one sheet at a time (keep remaining dough chilled and repeat process), until cookies appear set on the edges, but slightly underbaked in the center (est. 10-11 minutes).
8. Remove cookies from oven and gently press some of the remaining white chips into tops.
9. Let cool on baking sheet 5 minutes, then transfer to wire rack to cool.
10. Store in airtight container. (Tip: add a few bread slices or large flour tortilla in container with cookies to maintain softness.)
