

FAST FACTS—The Canada Goose

- Migratory: (travels in large numbers to a different place, and afforded the protections of the Migratory Bird Treaty Act)
- **Diet:** mostly **herbivorous** (grasses, grains, aquatic plants)
- Size: 30-43 inches long
- Wingspan: 3 feet, 11 inches to 6 feet, 3 inches!
- Lifespan: 10 to 24 years in the wild, and 40 years in captivity (the condition of being confined; in animals often used with regard to living in human "possession"-- in zoos, rehabilitation facilities, aviaries, etc.)
- Habitat: native to arctic (relating to the regions around the north pole) and temperate (mild temperatures) North America, but introdúced elsewhere
- Conservation Status: least-concern species (evaluated and categorized by the International Union for Conservation of Nature—IUCN—as plentiful, not threatened, near threatened or conservation-dependent based on distribution and population status; however, laws still regulate hunting and protect the nests)
- **Nesting:** April to June. Will lay 1-10 eggs, usually 5-6. Nest from three years of age. Incubate 24-30 days, (they walk, swim & eat within 24 hours; fly at 10 weeks).
- Maximum Flight Ceiling (how high they fly): unknown, but have been reported at 29,000 feet. (aircraft fly at 35,000-36,000 feet)

We're anxiously awaiting the hatching and fledging of Freda & Fred's goslings, predicted the week of May 20!


