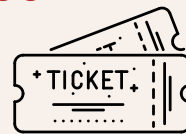

TAKING RESPONSIBILITY: Children learn responsibility by taking care of their things and completing small tasks. Give your child age-appropriate responsibilities, like putting away toys or feeding a pet. When kids take responsibility, they feel capable and trusted. Learning this skill early helps them develop independence. Being responsible also teaches kids that their actions affect others.

☛ **Try This:** Make a simple chore chart with pictures or stickers to track your child's tasks. Celebrate their effort with praise or a fun reward.

Freeman School District Nutrition Services (FSD-NS) will always feed students one full breakfast and one full lunch every day, regardless of free, reduced or paid status, and regardless of funding on a student's account. Even if a student has a negative balance on their meal account, FSD-NS will always serve a full meal if requested by the student.

However, please note that regardless of eligibility (F/R/P), if a student's meal account has a negative balance, FSD-NS will not serve a la carte items* to that student (chips, drinks, Rice Krispy Treats, individual milk or juice, etc.). We will serve these students a full breakfast or lunch if requested. Additionally, if a student wants a second serving of breakfast or lunch, there needs to be funds on the students account to pay for the second meal/entrée.
