





- providing first aid care and health assessment
- writing care plans and coordinating the care of students with chronic or acute health conditions
- communicating with teachers and staff to ensure the safety and well-being of students
- administering medications and monitoring delegated medication administration
- assisting in the evaluation of students for Special Services (Special Education)
- coordinating and providing vision and hearing screenings
- assisting families in accessing health insurance and health care services, and
- educating and training staff on: asthma, life threatening allergies, diabetes, and bloodborne pathogens.

To Audition...

- \Rightarrow Sign up beforehand with Mrs. Thompson, Elementary Room 134 (see next page)
- \Rightarrow Plan to attend just one date to audition.
- \Rightarrow Limit your act to 3 ½ minutes. YOU need to time your act to make sure you do not go over.

Be Prepared

- \Rightarrow Bring your completed permission slip to the audition. (required)
- \Rightarrow If you are using music, be prepared to communicate how to access it during the audition.
- ⇒ Your complete act should be ready to show the judges on your audition day. <u>NO changes</u> in your act after that day unless you have permission from your talent show director.

Some Rules

- ⇒ Absolutely no suggestive movement or inappropriate language. Suggestive dancing seen in most music videos is not appropriate for school. Please think about this <u>BE-FORE</u> the audition.
- \Rightarrow All songs & dances should be appropriate for *all ages* to see & hear at school.
- $\Rightarrow~$ If your act is not appropriate, you will not be cast in the show.
