Vaccinations – Sign up for MyIR (My Immunization Record) to see if your student needs any school-required immunizations.

Individual Health Plans (IHP) for Asthma, Diabetes, Life-Threatening Allergies, Seizures and other life-threatening conditions (complete yearly)

Medication authorization paperwork for medicine taken at school (complete yearly) Annual/sports physicals if your student will play sports (complete yearly)

Make your appointment NOW! Clinics are often booked MONTHS in advance, so don't wait. And don't forget to bring your important paperwork—many clinics charge a fee (\$20 or more) to complete paperwork outside of an appointment.


