Drop off/Pick up Reminders

Drop off: Please do not drop off before 7:50am. We do not have supervision before then.

Pick up: Please follow the line and continue to drive up the pick up line. Your child cannot get into the vehicle until you are in front of the cone. If you are parent pick up, park in a parking lot (not the valet line) and walk down to get your child.

EARLY Pick up: Please come into the office and sign your child out. We will call them down to the office to meet you. Remember your ID the first few times, so we can make sure you are in our system! Sometimes we have to re-scan it, so it is always better just to have it.

LATE Drop Off: If your child is late to school because of an appointment or otherwise, please escort them into the school and check them into the office.

All of these rules are in place for the students' safety. We appreciate your cooperation!

Communications

The elementary school's primary method of communication for ongoing news and activities is *The Scottie Scoop!*, emailed home most Fridays throughout the school year. Nutrition Services

The waiver from USDA Food & Nutrition Services that provided free lunches during COVID-19 has now expired. Free and reduced meals will be available to students who qualify as determined through the family's completion of the application for Free & Reduced Priced Meals. All families are asked to complete this application regardless of perceived eligibility. The data is used for qualifying for other programs. New applications for this school year are available through the link provided, and families will be notified following application. Elementary student meals are \$2.10 for breakfast and \$3.15 for lunch. Meals are open to all elementary students.
