# Drop off/Pick up Reminders

**Drop off:** Please do not drop off before 7:50am. We do not have supervision before then.

**Pick up:** Please follow the line and continue to drive up the pick up line. Your child cannot get into the vehicle until you are in front of the cone. If you are parent pick up, park in a parking lot (not the valet line) and walk down to get your child.
