CONSTRUCTION TECH 1 COURSE OUTLINE

Construction Technology 1 is a course designed to cover basic sketching and woodworking. This course will take those students with little or no experience in to a level of confidence and skill. Effort and improvement is a very important part of this course. Without hard work, it is difficult to reach a high level of skill. Since this is a vocational class, I will make an effort to treat the class as close to a normal work environment as possible.

Tech 1 will emphasize on basic sketching and woodworking. Sketching will consist of 2 dimensional using different scale and proportions. Woodworking will teach the safe and correct way to use a variety of tools and machinery in the shop area. Some of these machines include the table saw, miter saw, jointer, band saw, planer, drill press, router, lathe, and a wide variety of hand tools. Students will also be instructed in processes such as dadoing, doweling, gluing and clamping, sanding, and finishing. These and other processes will be taught through a variety of assigned projects. Some of these will include a cutting board, knife block, mug rack, lazy susan, box, and picture frame, along with others. Personal projects may be assigned to those who have completed all required projects 1st.

Major emphasis will be placed on proper and safe operation of all equipment in these areas. Students must abide by all safety rules and procedures to insure a safe working environment. Unsafe acts or conditions will not be tolerated and may result in the removal from the course. Through this class, I expect students to gain skills that will last them a lifetime. These skills can be used as a hobby or in a specific profession. In either case, it is great opportunity to gain life long skills.

GRADING:

A)	Daily – 50%	Daily worksheets, tests, participation, attendance, and clean up. Participation will be done daily on a 1-4 point scale. The participation rubric is attached. Absences can be made
		up before school from 7:30-8-00 most days. All make ups must be completed prior to the next 3 week grade period unless insufficient amount of time.

B) Projects – 50% Quality and craftsmanship of the finished project. Each project will be worth 25 pts.
