*ALL STUDENTS, whether on campus or not, are still expected to follow class expectations of working in Google Classroom, checking in for attendance purposes and turning work in on time, etc.

On Campus Learning Safety Protocols

- Masks are REQUIRED at all times other than when they are eating.
- Social Distancing is REQUIRED. There will be ONE-WAY traffic in the hallways before school, during passing periods, lunch and after school. Floors will be marked with arrows.
- Lockers: there will be NO LOCKERS AVAILABLE
- **Temperature Screening:** We will collect attestations and take temperatures every day.
- Assigned Seating: Students will be assigned a seat before school, in all classes and at lunch. This is a requirement for COVID safety protocols and contact tracing. We will work with the students on this the first week.

Arrival/Meals/Dismissal/Etc.

- Arrival—doors open at 8:30am Students can pick up breakfast and will remain at tables in MPR or hallway to get their temps checked and turn in attestations <u>until bell rings.</u>
- Classes—Students will go to their classes and have 15 minute passing between bells (ONE-WAY traffic in hallways).
- Lunch—available to students on campus. Those who get school lunch will have to social distance in line and go to assigned seat. Those who bring lunch will go straight to their seat.
- **Dismissal**—ALL STUDENTS will have to exit the building immediately after the last class at 2:15pm. ONE-WAY traffic in the halls.
