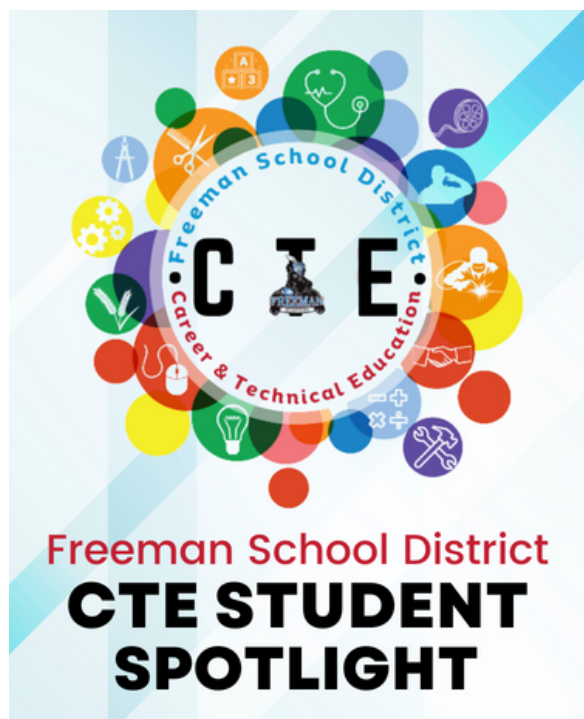




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## Charlie Howard



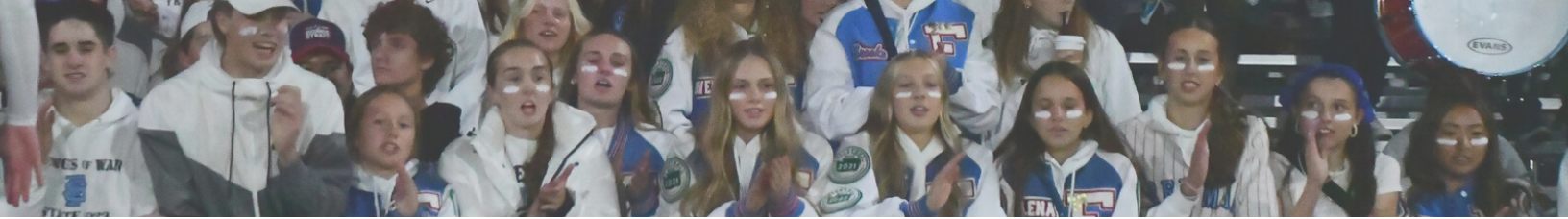
Charlie Howard is a senior at Freeman High School. She is deeply entrenched in the world of agriculture, FFA and 4H. Since a young age, she's been working with cattle and last year she took the plunge into showing her steer at events such as Kootenai Classic, Spokane Interstate Fair and the Junior Livestock Show.

"Handling a 1500 lb. animal in the ring takes patience, self-confidence and a certain level of grit that can only be learned by doing" says Charlie. Prioritizing the care and training of her animals is demanding. Charlie dedicates at least 4 hours a day, often starting before school, to prepare her animals and herself for upcoming shows. She's a keen observer, learning from peers who have incredible experience in this area. She also immerses herself in online resources, such as YouTube and livestock judging websites.

Charlie's sights are set on Walla Walla Community College in the fall, then transferring to the University of Idaho for agronomy and animal science. Her ambition is to build her own shown/beef cattle herd while aiming to become a professional livestock judge. In Charlie, you see resilience, determination and an unwavering passion for the future of agriculture.

## Winter Sports Admission Prices/Passes

Admission to all league games is \$7/adults and \$5/seniors or away students. Freeman High School & Middle School students get into home games for free with their ASB card. We accept cash and check at the gate as well as GoFan tickets whether you purchase them ahead of time on your device or at the gate with debit/credit card (fees apply).

We offer season passes for all home, regular-season games. This year ALL season passes must be purchased through GoFan. Below is a link to purchase them directly. Please note that the family passes include two adults and your children in Kindergarten - 6th grade. Senior passes are individual passes for seniors 60+.

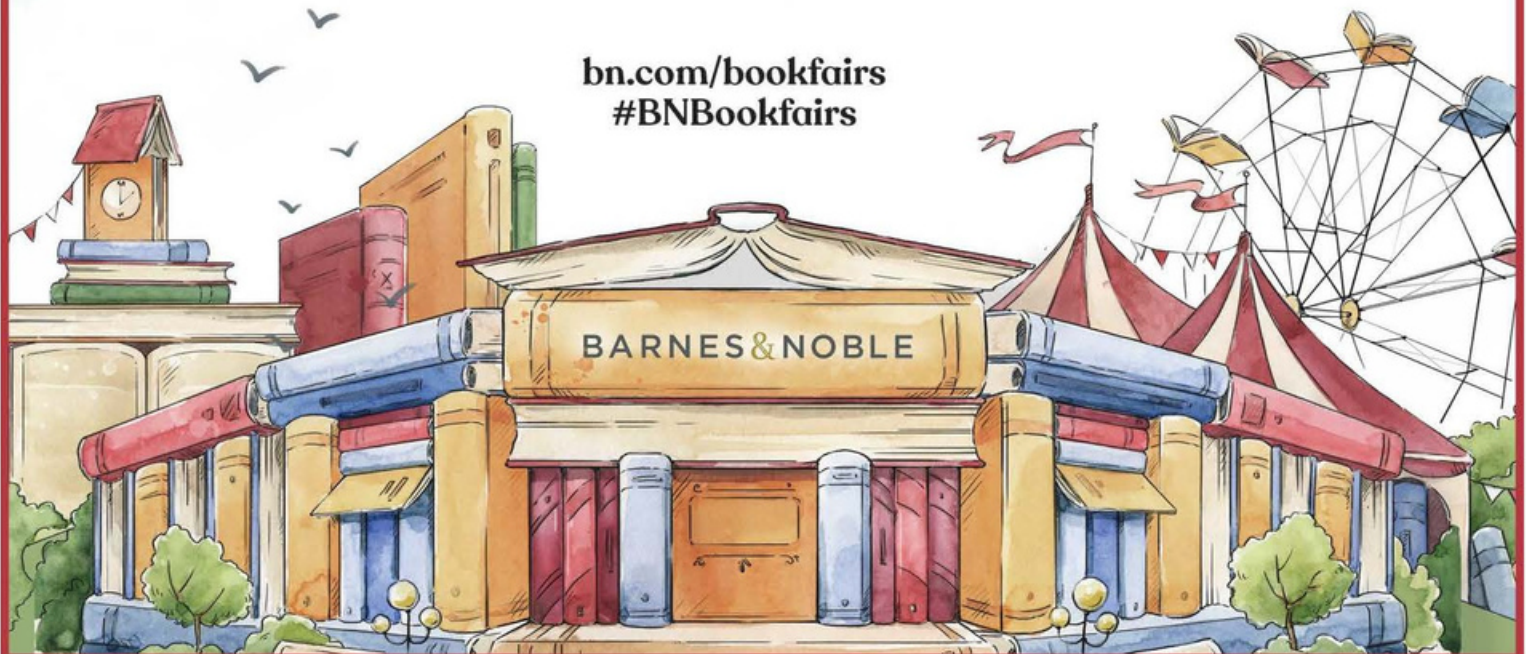
