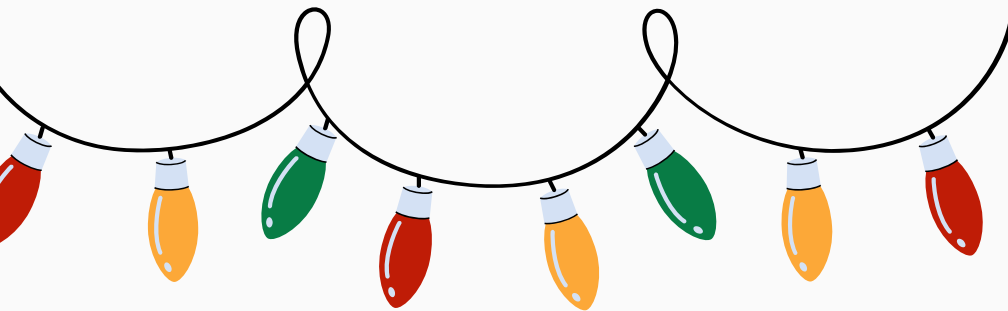

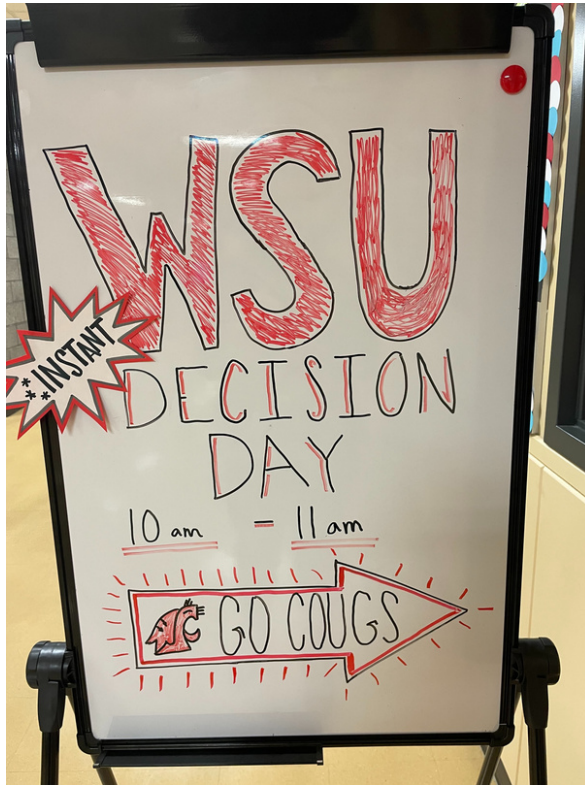
FS Leather Patch Hats

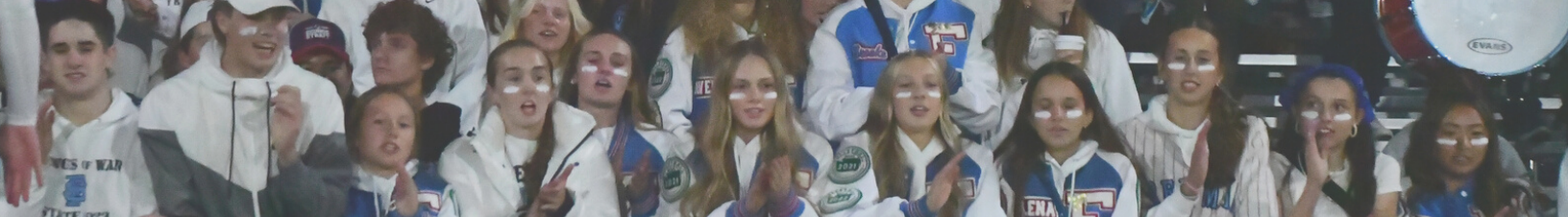

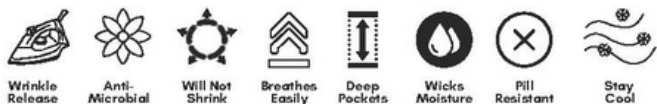
